Head of Environmental Strategy, Historic England

Hannah is an archaeologist with a PhD in the archaeology of human evolution and over 20 years' experience of archaeology and heritage management in research, commercial and public sectors. For the past 6 years Hannah has worked at Historic England, the public body that looks after England's historic environment, overseeing its work on climate change, increasing awareness of the relevance of heritage to climate change policy and action, and has become a leading voice on the subject. Hannah is a founding steering committee member of the Climate Heritage Network (founded at UN Climate Action Summit, San Francisco 2018), contributing author for the UK Climate Change Risk Assessment, and author of Historic England's Climate Change Adaptation Report. Hannah is a Co-Investigator on two AHRC funded research projects on heritage and climate change and advisor on a number of other climate related initiatives.
