Aims & Goals

- Determine whether Outstanding
 Universal Value has been maintained
 at the property level
- Encourage regional cooperation and networking
- Help update information on properties and record changes

Periodic Reporting is carried out on a **region by region** basis



- ✓ Promotes cooperation in the regions
- ✓ Responds to the specific characteristics of each region



Periodic Reporting Process

REPORTING IN REGIONS

National Focal Points complete the state-level report (**Section I**) while reports for each World Heritage property in the region (**Section II**) are completed by site

SUBMISSION

Reports are sent to the World Heritage Centre and Regional Reports are developed


REGIONAL REPORTS

are examined by the World Heritage Committee and recommendations are formulated

REGIONAL ACTION PLANS

are formulated setting strategies, priorities and goals for implementation of the World Heritage Convention



Regional Reports

- → Information on the conservation of World Heritage in a region
- → Main challenges faced
- → Trends related to regional or global phenomena
 - prepared by the World Heritage
 Centre in consultation with
 National Focal Points
 - presented to the World Heritage Committee

Regional Action Plans

- → Set regional priorities for the implementation of the World Heritage Convention
- → Translates the Periodic Reporting data into concrete goals and timeline
- formulated through a collaborative process that can involve national Focal Points, Site Managers, Advisory Bodies and the World Heritage Centre.
- a user-generated tool that incorporates the specific needs of Site Managers and States


